# Requirements

## To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a current graduate student or have recently graduated with a master's or doctoral degree with less than 3 years of post-graduation research experience.
- Have at least 1 semester of experience doing human subjects research.
- Self-identify as a person who is blind or has low vision.
- Be authorized to work in the U.S.
